Our past causes have ranged widely from charities with a physical or mental health focus, such as Parkinsons, spinal injuries or eating disorders, to those that seek to reach disadvantaged or marginalised people and provide them with skills and confidence to reach their full potential.

In 2025, The October Club's events raised more than £800,000 for Spark Inside, an award-winning charity that coaches young offenders approaching release. These funds will enable Spark Inside to expand from London to the Midlands, giving more young people the chance to break the cycle of reoffending and build meaningful futures.
